Partner- the person you are dancing with

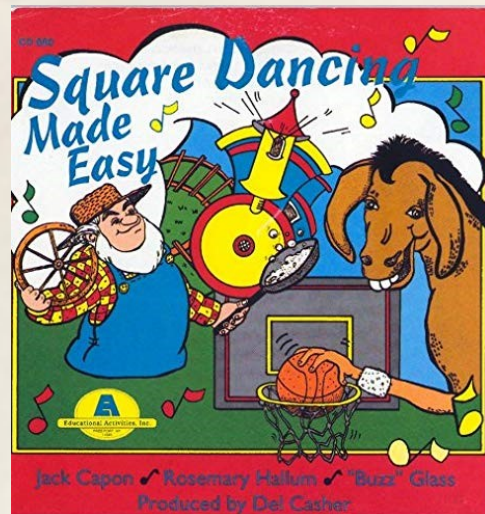
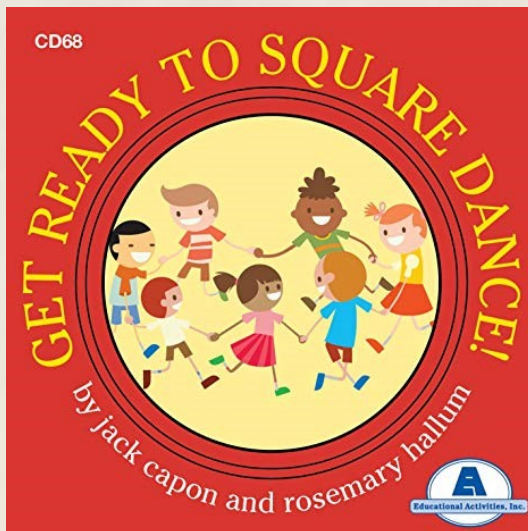
Promenade- a march performed by couples in a square or at the opening of a ball
